In the 1700's, Trinidad, populated mainly by Amerindians and handful of Spaniard and their slaves, was an island province of the Viceroyalty of New Spain. In 1783, the perception of the island's under-population prompted King Charles III of Spain to allow a grant of 32 acres of land in Trinidad for each foreign Roman Catholic man, woman, or child who swore allegiance to the Spanish king.

Trinidad and Tobago — History and Culture

By 1797, when Britain seized the island from Spain, Trinidad had begun its development as a plantation economy and a slave society. Trinidad was formally ceded to Britain in 1802. Under British rule, Trinidad's development as a sugar colony continued, although in 1806-07 the slave trade was completely prohibited. Slavery was abolished in two stages between 1834 and 1838, and the sugarcane planters were unable to secure the steady, tractable, and cheap labour they wanted.
